Job Description:

1. Develop a M&E plan for the Childline SA training department with particular emphasis on Training on Child Law inclusive of the Children's Act, Child Justice Act and Criminal Law (Sexual Offences and Related Matters) Amendment Act.
2. Assist in developing research questionnaires that facilitate the monitoring of the implementation of the above legislation.
3. Assist in the collation of the above research/evaluation instruments

4. Write quarterly reports on both the training evaluations, and M&E of the implementation of the above legislation, focusing on conclusions and constructive recommendations relating to the improvement of training and implementation of child law
5. Support the PEPFAR OVC M&E Officer in her M&E activities in the 4 Childline Offices which will be receiving PEPFAR OVC grant money.
6. Continue with the collection, collation and interpretation of the statistics drawn from the Childline Counselling line and with the use of this data for the improvement of services to children.
