Location: Pietermaritzburg, KwaZulu – Natal

Degree Requirements: A Qualified and Experienced SACSSP registered Social Worker with a Masters qualification

Personal Requirements: To apply for this position you must have completed a Masters Degree or have completed 80% of your Masters course work. South African citizenship or permanent residence is essential.

Contract: 12 months

Commencement Date: 1 March 2012 or 1 June 2012

Job Description:

CCP requires a Social Worker to assist in the development of further services for children, families and adults infected or affected through HIV and Aids, paying particular attention to Children Orphaned or made Vulnerable to HIV or Aids, Children who test HIV+ and those at risk of child protection issues.

The Social work post will have areas of responsibility including:

- Assisting children and families accessing ID documentation and Grants by working with local Government Departments and other Child Welfare NGO's
- Carry a case load as necessary
- Deal with Child protection cases, working with relevant other parties and working with local Government Departments and other Child Welfare NGO's
- Training into areas of Early Childhood Development, Child Protection, Report Writing and Youth and Community Work
- Psychosocial Support to child, adults and families including counseling, bereavement and memory work individually and in groups
- Look at the development and support of local HIV+ Support groups for children and adults who are HIV+

As A multidisciplinary team the Social Work post will work closely with other areas of operation including our Schools and Community work, our Health and Household Economic Strengthening work and our training team.

A flexible and diligent person is required who has a passion for young people, family support and community development.
